Duration

Normally allow 4 days including assessments. Please note this is subject to the existing knowledge and experience of students, group size. Duration will also be subject to favourable or adverse weather conditions. Course duration may be varied slightly to allow for these variable factors.

Port Hacking, meeting at Yowie Bay Boat ramp.

What to bring

Warm clothing and a change of clothing, food, water, sun protection, and Proof of identity.

Course overview

Day 1

- Training is conducted in one seminar format using the Sailingworld “ASQA Course PowerPoint Slides”.
- The theory assessment of these units is then conducted using the Sailingworld “Boating Written Test Questions Evaluation” document, consisting of 60 multiple choice questions. Students are allowed one hour to complete this test and 100% of the questions must be answered correctly for the student to be assessed as competent.
- If a student fails the assessment they can review relevant course content and re-attempt the assessment.

Day 2

- On-board practical training sessions are conducted with small groups of 4-6 students. The duration and content of this training can be modified to meet the needs and experience of the students in the group.

Day 3

- Practical competency assessment is conducted using the Sailingworld “Boating Practical Observation” document, in which students are required to demonstrate competencies against the criteria set out in this assessment document. The observation sessions for Training Package units MEM50008, MEM50009, and MEM50010 usually require one full day to complete.

Day 4

- With boating there’s plenty of variables such as inclement weather. Day 4 may or may not be used but we wish to be transparent and upfront with students that this day may be required to complete activities. Students should allow this extra day in their diary.

This Student Manual is issued to all prospective students and must be read by all students before course enrolment.
